From this point of view, secondary special education students have the opportunity to save more parents from family exploitation, to spend more time here in the world of information resources, attracting them to creativity, science, books, the computer world. On top of that, qualified teachers are always ready to help, to guide the path of creativity.

The second is the introduction of interactive lessons, interesting and memorable, competitive styles of the educational process, the continuous conduct of various incentive competitions, which marked a radical renewal of the system of secondary special education. It aroused the enthusiasm and enthusiasm of the population, especially young people, for vocational training, led to the formation of feelings of patriotism and love for the motherland. For example, in the cities of Shakhrisabiz, Nasaf, Termez, Boysun and other ancient historical sites, in the regions where the graves, tombs and other structures of world-famous scholars of Uzbek national values are located, for example, in history or patriotism, the beauty of our values The process is carried out in the form of excursions directly to these objects, with a comprehensive teacher's commentary. In addition, in the system of secondary special education, young poets and poetesses, masters of ancient values such as coppersmithing, knife-making, tandoor-making, ceramics began to be known to the people. For example: Through question-and-answer sessions, or in the classroom, students are divided into groups, and in the course of the lesson, in the form of competitive competitions on a subject or a subject of the lesson, very interesting lessons are organized. As a result, negative situations began to take shape in the interactive learning process that required reforms. One of them is that students are starting to miss classes. False indications occurred in attendance. The third was that the above teacher could not change his style. The low level of efficiency, the lack of free and active learning processes have had a serious impact on the development activities of some secondary special education institutions. Even student enrollment has dropped dramatically It was expected that the number of young people who continue their education in the system of secondary special education, as well as those who successfully pass the vocational training and start their careers as entrepreneurs will increase. For example, among the graduates of 2017, 8.3 thousand young people who want to start their own business were provided with soft loans by commercial banks in the amount of 57.4 billion soums², and today they continue to work systematically with people who want to start their own business. \$ 700 million will be raised³ for employment purposes, and young people who are able to draw the right conclusions from the wide avenues and great opportunities opened up for small businesses have begun to showcase their talents in these areas of entrepreneurship. Especially in the field of various services for domestic service cars, hotels and tourism, trade, production of building materials, the number of those who started to engage in entrepreneurship began to increase. At the same time, there are cases when a certain number of young people graduating from secondary special education go abroad as migrant workers in order to earn money or voluntarily, often behind the obligatory referral of their parents, without gaining any experience in their profession and knowledge. . For example, in 2018, 52% of those who went abroad as migrant workers were 16-30 years old, and 70.2% of them had secondary special education⁴. Of course, the spiritual and legal knowledge of these young people is not enough to work abroad, especially the lack of knowledge of foreign languages and the inability to defend themselves legally became clear.

Demonstrating the need for a speedy solution in the secondary special education system, the establishment of legal education for young people and the need to pay serious attention to improving the legal literacy of young people in the secondary special education system and foreign language teaching should be introduced into the educational process.
